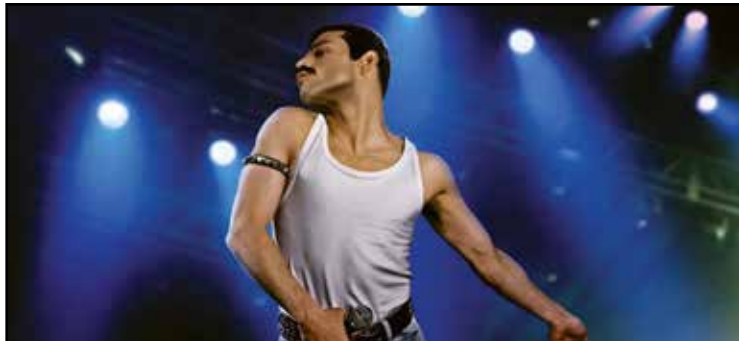


## EVENT & FILM GUIDE – FEBRUARY 2019



### Bohemian Rhapsody (M)

Running Time: 135 minutes

*Bohemian Rhapsody* is a foot-stomping celebration of Queen, their music and their extraordinary lead singer **Freddie Mercury**. Freddie defied stereotypes and shattered convention to become one of the most beloved entertainers on the planet.

The film traces the meteoric rise of the band through their iconic songs and revolutionary sound. They reach unparalleled success, but in an unexpected turn Freddie, surrounded by darker influences, shuns Queen in pursuit of his solo career. Having suffered greatly without the collaboration of Queen, Freddie manages to reunite with his bandmates just in time for Live Aid. Facing a life-threatening illness, Freddie leads the band in one of the greatest performances in the history of rock music. Queen cements a legacy that continues to inspire outsiders, dreamers and music lovers to this day.



### Green Book (M)

Running Time: 130 minutes

Starring **Viggo Mortensen** and **Mahershala Ali**, *Green Book* is the uplifting true story of a friendship that defied the odds. Set in 1962, the film follows Italian-American Tony Lip (**Mortensen**), who is hired to chauffeur African-American pianist Dr. Don Shirley (**Ali**) on a concert tour through the Deep South.



### Storm Boy (PG)

Running Time: 99 minutes

A beautiful and contemporary retelling of **Colin Thiele's** classic Australian tale.

*Storm Boy* has grown up to be Michael Kingley, a successful retired businessman and grandfather. When Kingley starts to see images from his past that he can't explain, he is forced to remember his long-forgotten childhood, growing up on an isolated coastline with his father. He recounts to his granddaughter the story of how, as a boy, he rescued and raised an extraordinary orphaned pelican, Mr Percival. Their remarkable adventures and very special bond has a profound effect on all their lives.

Based on the beloved book, *Storm Boy* is a timeless story of an unusual and unconditional friendship.



### The Mule (M)

Running Time: 116 minutes

**Clint Eastwood** stars as Earl Stone, a man in his 80s who is broke, alone, and facing foreclosure of his business when he is offered a job that simply requires him to drive. Easy enough, but, unbeknownst to Earl, he's just signed on as a drug courier for the cartel.

## Hurricane (M)

Running Time: 107 minutes

Directed by Bafta & Emmy award winner **David Blair** and based on the true story of **Jan Zumbach** (**Iwan Rheon** - *Game of Thrones*, *Misfits*) during WWII.

*Hurricane* is the tale of the Polish pilot who alongside his comrades of the Polish Air Force joins the British Royal Air Force to fight during the Battle of Britain. Having seen Warsaw burn, Poland crumble and France capitulate, the Poles join the Brits to push back the rampant Nazi empire. Initially, the British don't trust the Polish men, and the pilots must contend against a barrage of animosity.

Exhaustion and nerves take a terrible toll on the men as they are pushed to the limit by constant aerial warfare in a fight to save their own country above a foreign land.



## Vice (M)

Running Time: 132 minutes

The story of Dick Cheney, the most powerful Vice President in history, and how his policies changed the world as we know it.

*Vice* explores the epic story about how a bureaucratic Washington insider quietly became the most powerful man in the world as Vice-President to George W. Bush, reshaping the country and the globe in ways that we still feel today. With a stellar cast including **Christian Bale**, **Amy Adams**, **Steve Carell** and **Sam Rockwell**.



## At Eternity's Gate (M)

Running Time: 111 minutes

**Julian Schnabel's** *At Eternity's Gate* is a journey inside the world and mind of a person who, despite skepticism, ridicule and illness, created some of the world's most beloved and stunning works of art. This is not a forensic biography, but rather scenes based on **Vincent van Gogh's** (Academy Award® Nominee *Willem Dafoe*) letters, common agreement about events in his life that present as facts, hearsay, and moments that are just plain invented.



## In The Zone (Ex)

Running Time: 115 minutes

At a time when the world has never seemed more divided, *In The Zone* is a story about a man who, despite all the obstacles, is trying to bring people together. And it's working.

**Terrance Wallace** has already enabled over a hundred minority teenagers in New Zealand to create educational and personal success through a pioneering scheme which gives them access to influential schools with opportunities previously beyond their reach.

Over time, Terrance has become a father-figure to many of the teens in his care, and has encouraged them to in turn inspire and empower others. But with his own family directly impacted by escalating political tension and violence back home in the USA, he begins to face the heart-wrenching decision of choosing between the kids for whom he is a guardian and mentor, and his own community in Chicago.

Throughout its powerful narrative, this film raises poignant questions about education, privilege, diversity, and cycles of inequality across the Western world, and shows us that nobody is too small to make a difference.
