Hustlers (R16)

Running Time: 110 minutes

Inspired by a true story. At the start of 2007, Destiny is a young woman struggling to make ends meet. Her life is forever changed when she meets Ramona, the club's top money earner, who's always in control, has the clientele figured out, and really knows her way around a pole. The two women bond immediately, and Ramona gives Destiny a crash course in the various poses and pole moves.



Ride Like A Girl (PG)

Running Time: 98 minutes

As a little girl, **Michelle Payne** dreams of the impossible: winning the Melbourne Cup horse-racing's toughest two-mile race. The youngest of 10 children, Michelle is raised by single father Paddy. She leaves school at 15 to become a jockey and after early failures she finds her feet, but a family tragedy, followed by her own near fatal horse fall all but ends the dream. But with the love of her dad and her brother Stevie, Michelle will not give up. Against all the medical advice, and the protests of her siblings, she rides on, and meets the Prince of Penzance. Together they overcome impossible odds for a shot at the dream: a ride in the 2015 Melbourne Cup, at odds of 100 to 1. The rest is history.



Hillary: Ocean to Sky (Ex)

Running Time: 110 minutes

Sir Edmund Hillary's journey from the Ocean to the Sky along India's holy River Ganges was his last major expedition. For the people of India, it was a pilgrimage led by a hero of almost god-like status and millions lined the river to watch him pass in his 'miraculous' jet boats. For Ed and his 22-year-old son, Peter, it was a healing journey too, as they came to terms with the recent loss of Ed's beloved wife, Louise and daughter Belinda. To Sir Ed, it always remained 'the best journey of them all.'



Downton Abbey (PG)

The continuing story of the Crawley family, wealthy owners of a large estate in the English countryside in the early 20th century.

A struggling Mumbai street photographer pressured to marry by his grandmother convinces a shy stranger to pose as his fiancée during a family visit. Despite vast cultural differences, the pair develop a surprising connection that challenges their worldviews in a wistful and funny romance from Ritesh Batra (*The Lunchbox*). Rafi (**Nawazuddin Siddiqui**) came to Mumbai from a small village to earn money to pay off an old family debt. Working as a street photographer, he shares one small room with friends and sends almost everything he makes to his grandmother, Dadi (**Farrukh Jaffar**), in the hope she will be able to buy back her ancestral home. To satisfy the elderly woman's desire for him to marry, he sends her a photo of a shy stranger, claiming that the girl, Miloni (**Sanya Malhotra**), is his fiancée.

When his grandmother insists on a meeting, he tracks Miloni down and asks her to pretend to be his betrothed. A sheltered young woman studying to become an accountant, Miloni lives a quiet, middle-class life with her parents, and awaits an arranged marriage to a suitable boy when she finishes school. She impulsively agrees to Rafi's scheme, opening the door to an unexpected adventure at the crossroads of tradition and modernity. Featuring some of Indian cinema's most popular actors, *Photograph* is a heartwarming and comical snapshot of life in contemporary Mumbai.



EOS: Rembrandt (Ex)

Running Time: 91 minutes

To mark the 350th anniversary of Rembrandt's death and the Year of the Dutch Golden Age, *Exhibition On Screen* presents Rembrandt, back by popular demand. Filmed in exquisite detail, the camera offers a privileged view of the once-in-a-lifetime 2015 Late Works exhibition at the Amsterdam's *Rijksmuseum* and London's *National Gallery*.
