One Life (PG)

Running Time: 108 minutes

One Life tells the inspiring true story of **Sir Nicholas 'Nicky' Winton**, whose unsung endeavours on the eve of **World War II** saved more than 600 children from their doom. Nicky considered himself a banker, not a humanitarian. Yet when he visited a recently annexed **Prague** in 1938 and saw the state of the fleeing Jewish refugees, he did what he believed was the right thing to do – the thing that anyone would do – and dedicated himself to the cause. War was approaching, and it was a race against time. How many children could he liberate before it ran out?

Fifty years later, it's 1988 and Nicky is haunted by the fate of the children he wasn't able to help. And so it's not until he's surprised by the survivors on live television that he can accept that when facing devastating atrocities, saving even one life is a victory, and the British public learn the truth about the hero hidden in their midst.



Argylle (M)

Running Time: 135 minutes

From the twisted mind of **Matthew Vaughn** (*Kingsman franchise, Kick-Ass*) comes *Argylle*, a razor-witted, reality-bending, globe-encircling spy thriller.

Bryce Dallas Howard (*Jurassic World* franchise) is Elly Conway, the reclusive author of a series of best-selling espionage novels, whose idea of bliss is a night at home with her computer and her cat, Alfie. But when the plots of Elly's fictional books—which center on secret agent Argylle and his mission to unravel a global spy syndicate—begin to mirror the covert actions of a real-life spy organization, quiet evenings at home become a thing of the past.

Accompanied by Aiden (**Oscar®** winner **Sam Rockwell**), a cat-allergic spy, Elly (carrying Alfie in her backpack) races across the world to stay one step ahead of the killers as the line between Elly's fictional world and her real one begins to blur.

When teenage **Priscilla Beaulieu** meets **Elvis Presley** at a party, the man who is already a meteoric rock-and-roll superstar becomes someone entirely unexpected in private moments: a thrilling crush, an ally in loneliness, a vulnerable best friend.



The Boys in the Boat (M)

Running Time: 124 minutes

The Boys in the Boat is a sports drama based on the #1 New York Times bestselling non-fiction book written by **Daniel James Brown**. The film, directed by **George Clooney**, is about the 1936 University of Washington rowing team that competed for gold at the Summer Olympics in Berlin. This inspirational true story follows a group of underdogs at the height of the Great Depression as they are thrust into the spotlight and take on elite rivals from around the world.



Ferrari (R16)

During the summer of 1957, bankruptcy looms over the company that **Enzo Ferrari** and his wife built 10 years earlier. He decides to roll the dice and wager it all on the iconic *Mille Miglia*, a treacherous 1,000-mile race across Italy.



The Holdovers (M)

Running Time: 133 minutes

From acclaimed director **Alexander Payne**, *The Holdovers* follows a curmudgeonly instructor (**Paul Giamatti**) at a New England prep school who is forced to remain on campus during Christmas break to babysit the handful of students with nowhere to go. Eventually he forms an unlikely bond with one of them -- a damaged, brainy troublemaker (newcomer **Dominic Sessa**) -- and with the school's head cook, who has just lost a son in Vietnam (**Da'Vine Joy Randolph**).
