Baby Done (M) Running Time: 91 minutes

When Zoe (**Rose Matafeo**) and Tim (**Matthew Lewis**) find out they are having a baby, they resolve to not let parenthood change them. Tim runs towards being a dad, while Zoe runs away from being a mum. Terrified that her life won't be her own anymore, Zoe is still determined to tick off a list of their wildest dreams before the baby arrives. I am Woman (M) Running Time: 116 minutes

I am Woman is the story of **Helen Reddy**, who in 1966 landed in New York with her three-year-old daughter, a suitcase and \$230 in her pocket. Within weeks she was broke. Within months she was in love. Within five years she was one of the biggest superstars of her time, and an icon of the 1970s feminist movement, who wrote a song which galvanised a generation of women to fight for change.



The Mystery of Henri Pick (M) Running Time: 101 minutes

The Mystery of Henri Pick revolves around the film's enigmatic title character who, two years after his death, has his name sprawled across the covers of a celebrated novel, *The Last Hours of a Love Story*. However, not everyone is convinced of the author's authenticity of this overnight sensation. Amongst the cynics is influential literary critic Jean-Michel Rouche **(Fabrice Luchini)** who sets out to discover the truth behind Pick and the book that bears his name. **Camille Cottin** co-stars as Joséphine Pick, daughter of the mysterious author, who reluctantly assists Rouche in navigating the secretive Breton landscape.

The More You Ignore Me (M)

Running Time: 98 minutes

British dysfunctional family comedy starring BAFTA nominees Sheridan Smith (*TV's Cilla*) and Mark Addy (*The Full Monty*) A young, rural England mother (Smith) struggling with mental illness develops an obsession with the local weatherman, which leads to an admission to a psychiatric hospital. Her daughter Alice (Ella Hunt, Anna and the Apocalypse) struggles to relate to her heavily medicated mum, and chaos ensues when she attempts to reconnect with her.



The Secret - Dare to Dream (PG) Running Time: 107 minutes

The Secret: Dare to Dream centers around Miranda Wells (Katie Holmes), a hard-working young widow struggling to raise three children on her own. A powerful storm brings a devastating challenge and a mysterious man, Bray Johnson (Josh Lucas), into her life. In just a few short days, Bray's presence re-ignites the family's spirit, but he carries a secret—and that secret could change everything.



The Secret Garden (PG)

Running Time: 100 minutes

The Secret Garden tells the story of Mary Lennox (Dixie Egerickx), a prickly and unloved 10-year-old, born in India to wealthy British parents. When they suddenly die, she is sent back to England to live with her uncle, Archibald Craven (Colin Firth) on his remote country estate deep in the Yorkshire moors. There, she begins to uncover many family secrets, particularly after meeting her sickly cousin Colin (Edan Hayhurst), who has been shut away in a wing of the house. Together, these two damaged, slightly misfit children heal each other through their discovery of a wondrous secret garden, lost in the grounds of Misselthwaite Manor - a magical place of adventure that will change their lives forever.
