Thelma (M) Running Time: 89 minutes

The feature directorial debut of **Josh Margolin**, *Thelma* is a poignant action-comedy that gives veteran **Oscar®** nominee **June Squibb** her first leading role and features the final performance of trailblazing actor **Richard Roundtree**. A feisty 93-year-old grandmother who gets conned by a phone scammer pretending to be her grandson and sets out on a treacherous quest across Los Angeles, accompanied by an aging friend (**Roundtree**) and his motorized scooter, to reclaim what was taken from her.

Inspired by a real-life experience of **Margolin**'s own grandmother, *Thelma* puts a clever spin on movies like *Mission:Impossible*, shining the spotlight on an elderly grandmother as an unlikely action hero. With infectious humor, **Margolin** employs the familiar tropes of the action genre in hilarious, age-appropriate ways to tackle aging with agency. **Squibb** portrays the strong-willed *Thelma* with grit and determination, demonstrating that she is more than capable of taking care of business – despite what her daughter Gail (**Posey**), son-in-law Alan (**Gregg**), or grandson Danny might believe.



A Horse Named Winx (PG) Running Time: 121 minutes

A Horse Named Winx tells the inspirational story of one of Australia's greatest athletes. At the height of her fame, Winx became known as the "people's horse"—an Australian icon who transcended her sport—joining the realms of fellow legends like Cathy Freeman and Sir Donald Bradman. Although the world's greatest racehorse retired in 2019, she's still breaking records. Winx's only foal sold this year at auction for a world record \$10 million dollars. During her reign, huge crowds descended on racetracks across Australia to witness the Phar Lap of the modern era pull off the impossible—33 straight wins—a feat unlikely to ever be repeated.

Winx's final race was watched by millions worldwide. From the wilful foal who was hard to catch, to a plain leggy teenager who kept to herself and turned her back on affection, Winx became a front page phenomenon, and in the process thrust her trainer Chris Waller and jockey Hugh Bowman onto the world stage. But away from the cameras, coping with the enormous pressure of maintaining the winning streak was testing Team Winx to the limit.

The Apprentice (TBC) Running Time: 120 minutes

A young **Donald Trump** (Sebastian Stan), eager to make his name as a hungry second son of a wealthy family in 1970s **New York**, comes under the spell of **Roy Cohn** (Jeremy Strong), the cutthroat attorney who would help create the **Donald Trump** we know today. **Cohn** sees in **Trump** the perfect protégé—someone with raw ambition, a hunger for success, and a willingness to do whatever it takes to win.



Rosalie (M) Running Time: 111 minutes

Set in 1870s **France**, *Rosalie*, portrayed by the radiant **Nadia Tereszkiewicz**, is an extraordinary young woman harboring a secret. Abel (**Benoît Magimel**), an indebted tavern owner unaware of her secret, marries *Rosalie* for her dowry. When *Rosalie* defiantly decides to embrace her unconventional appearance, the central question emerges: Can Abel truly love her and see beyond her physical differences, once he discovers the truth?

Rosalie draws inspiration from the experiences of historical figures, weaving a passionate and empowering drama that serves as a beautifully crafted parable on intolerance and attitudes toward body diversity. Directed by **Stéphanie Di Giusto**, known for her acclaimed debut *The Dancer, Rosalie* tenderly explores the triumph of hope and love in a world marked by prejudice.

Runt (PG) Running Time: 92 minutes

Craig Silvey's beloved best-selling novel leaps onto the big screen in a charming new Australian family movie. *Runt* is the heartfelt and hilarious tale of eleven-year-old Annie Shearer and her best friend *Runt*, an adopted stray dog with remarkable abilities. In a bid to save their family farm, the two aspire to compete in the Agility Course Championships at the prestigious Krumpets Dog Show in **London**, whilst overcoming hurdles, obstacles and nefarious villains.




Six Inches of Soil (Ex) Running Time: 96 minutes

Six Inches of Soil tells the inspiring story of young **British** farmers standing up against the industrial food system and transforming the way they produce food - to heal the soil, our health and provide for local communities.

Half the food eaten in the UK is produced by about 180,000 farmers, who manage 70% of our land. Current "industrial" mainstream farming practices significantly contribute to soil degradation, biodiversity loss and climate change. Regenerative farming practices, (within an agroecological system) promote healthier soils, provide healthier, affordable food, restore biodiversity and sequester carbon.

Six Inches of Soil is a story of three new farmers on the first year of their regenerative journey to heal the soil and help transform the food system - Anna Jackson, a Lincolnshire 11th generation arable and sheep farmer; Adrienne Gordon, a Cambridgeshire small-scale vegetable farmer; and Ben Thomas, who rears pasture fed beef cattle in Cornwall. As the trio of young farmers strive to adopt regenerative practices and create viable businesses, they meet seasoned mentors who help them on their journey.


