Wicked: For Good (PG)

Running Time: 137 minutes

And now whatever way our stories end, I know you have rewritten mine by being my friend ...

Wicked: For Good brings last year's global cinematic sensation, the most successful **Broadway** film adaptation of all time, to its epic conclusion. Award-winning director **Jon M.**Chu and the spectacular returning cast, led by **Academy Award®** nominated superstars **Cynthia**Erivo and Ariana Grande, bring audiences the final chapter of the untold story of the witches of Oz.

Elphaba (Cynthia Erivo), now demonized as the Wicked Witch of the West, lives in exile while she continues to fight for the freedom of Oz's silenced Animals. Glinda (Ariana Grande), meanwhile, has become a symbol of Goodness for all of Oz. Under the instruction of Madame Morrible (Michelle Yeoh), she reassures the masses that all is well under the rule of The Wizard (Jeff Goldblum). With her spectacular wedding to Prince Fiyero (Jonathan Bailey) approaching, Glinda attempts to broker a conciliation between Elphaba and The Wizard. When those efforts fail, not only do they drive Elphaba and Glinda further apart, but the aftershocks will transform Bog (Ethan Slater) and Fiyero forever, and threaten the safety of Elphaba's sister, Nessarose (Marissa Bode), when a girl from Kansas comes crashing into all their lives.

As an angry mob rises against the Wicked Witch, Glinda and Elphaba will need to come together one final time to truly see each other, with honesty and empathy, if they are to change themselves, and all of Oz, for good.



Nuremberg (M) Running Time: 148 minutes

The world will bear witness.

The Allies, led by the unyielding chief prosecutor, Robert H. Jackson (Michael Shannon), have the task of ensuring the Nazi regime answers for the unveiled horrors of the Holocaust while a US Army psychiatrist (Rami Malek) is locked in a dramatic psychological duel with former Reichsmarschall Herman Göring (Russell Crowe).



The Scammers (M)

On a picturesque island in Brittany, lifelong friends Jean-Jean (**Didier Bourdon**) and Henri (**Gérard Darmon**) find their quiet existence disrupted when one of their fellow villagers wins millions in the national lottery.

The pair hatch a plan to befriend the lucky local and hopefully share in the winnings... only to find the winner has died of shock - ticket in hand!

Jean-Jean and Henri must devise another scheme. In order to claim the prize, the friends will simply steal the unlucky winner's identity...

However, the pair soon realise that to fool the lottery officials in such a small town, they'll have to convince the villagers - who all want a piece of the pie - to back their daring plan.

En route she discovers a teenage girl, kidnapped and held hostage in an isolated cabin in the middle of nowhere. With no phone service and hours from the nearest town, she has become the young girl's only hope for survival... but at what cost to herself?



Twiggy (M)
Running Time: 94 minutes

Introducing *Twiggy*, an upcoming documentary focused on the life and times of the greatest 'IT' girl of all time, **Dame Lesley Lawson**, better known as **Twiggy**. The first time **Twiggy** has ever told her story, her life is presented through her working class childhood in northwest **London**, her international stardom and her career as an acclaimed actress, singer, fashion designer, writer and TV presenter.



Beat the Lotto (G)
