CANCELLATION POLICY:

We reserve the right to cancel or postpone classes. If we need to cancel a class for whatever reason, you will be entitled to a partial refund of the fees paid for the cancelled class. Hawkins Youth Theatre Company (HYTC) reserves the right to terminate or cancel this agreement and remove a child from the class, if at any time it believes that any child or parent/ guardian of that child behaves in a manner that in its sole discretion, HYTC believes is inappropriate, disruptive or intimidating in any manner. HYTC need give no reasons for any such termination and will not refund class fees. HYTC sets all class rules accordingly to its own decision process.

YOUTH WELFARE:

The safety, wellbeing and happiness of youth at the Hawkins Theatre is a matter of great importance to us. In the event of illness or injury, tutors are instructed to err on the side of caution contacting appropriate medical help and parents promptly.
